
Our Data is From NJDEP

What Should My Recycling Rate Be?

As amended in 1987 the Recycling Act calls for the recycling of 50% of the municipal solid waste stream and 60% of the overall waste stream by the end of 1995!.

Total Recycling + Total Solid Waste Disposed











Combined HHW & Ewaste Totals 2018 - 2020
